## Summary

The user receives a notification that their web mail is being improved with a system and to click on a link to proceed with updating to the new and improved system. The link takes the user to a fraudulent website which appears to already be removed by the website host company.

## Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to obtain BeachID account credentials for their own malicious purposes.
