
Summary

The user receives an email indicating they must updated with 72 hours and to click on a link to upgrade their account. The link goes to a fraudulent site, which look like Outlook Web App (OWA). This has also been reported to the website host as abuse.

Intent of the Email

The sender is attempting to obtain account information for their own malicious purposes.

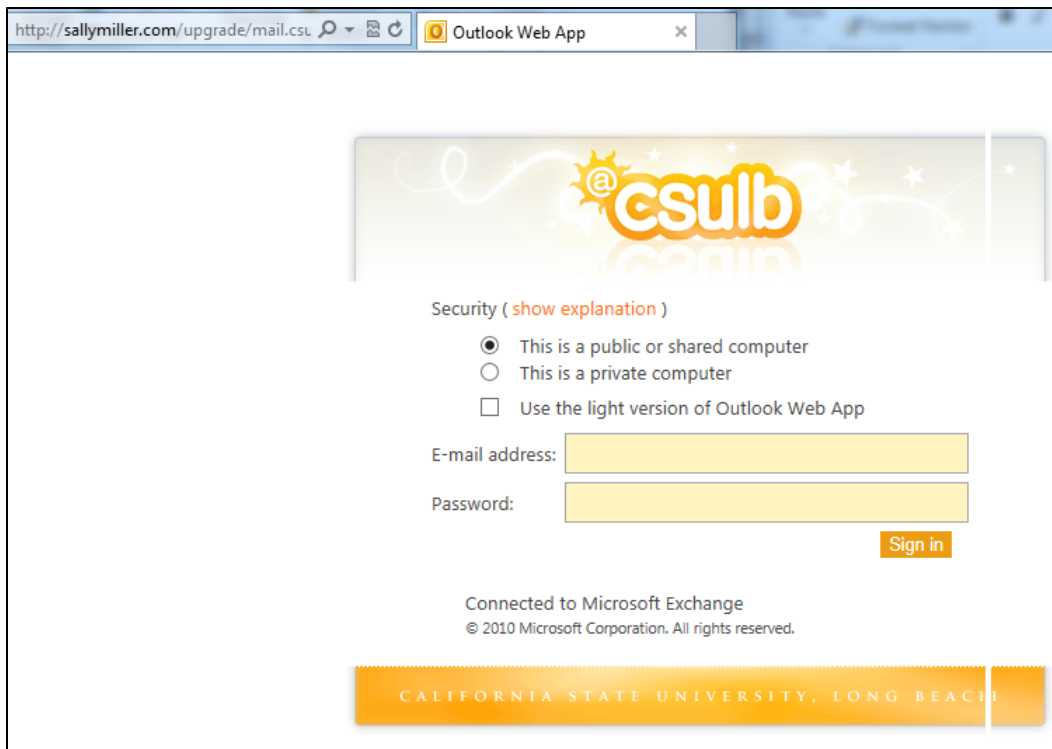


Figure 2: Screenshot of the fraudulent phishing site page
