Summary

The fraudulent email claims to be from Microsoft and requests to click on a link to avoid account termination. CSULB never asks employees to click on a link to verify their email account or campus provided Microsoft services, and services are only terminated upon separation from the University depending on your role.

Intent of the Email

The phisher/sender is attempting to capture email account credentials for their own malicious purposes.

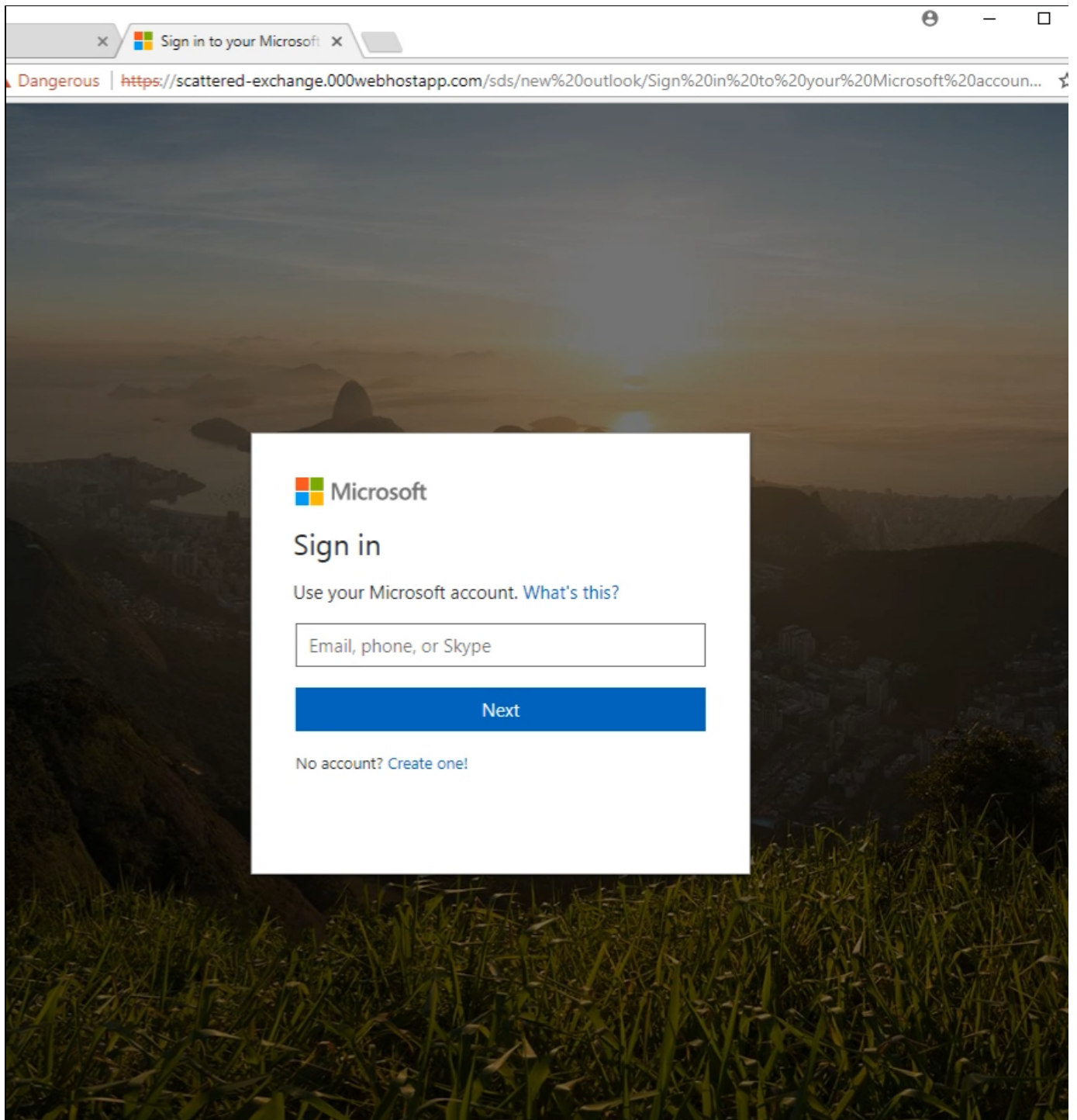


Figure 2: Screenshot of the fraudulent phishing page
